This scholarship will be awarded to the student who goes above and beyond all others in volunteering with the Houston Community Association.

Additional scholarships of \$500 will be awarded to all other deserving Houston High School graduating students in memory of a former trustee who was fundamental in the history of the Houston Community Association.

## **Eligibility:**

- Applicant must have applied and been accepted to an accredited institution.
- Applicant must be a member of the Houston High School graduating class.
- Applicant must have volunteered for Houston Community Association events during junior high and/or high school.

#### Deadline:

Applicant must complete application form and submit to Mrs. Merickel by the end of the school day on the first Wednesday in May.

### **Notification:**

The scholarship recipient(s) will be notified during the Houston High School graduation ceremony.

The Houston Community Association, Inc. reserves final judgement regarding all aspects of the selection and eligibility requirements, including award amounts.
